

WHAT IS THE INTRAMURAL PROGRAM?


The Intramural Program at the WLU is designed to provide an opportunity for every student to participate in organized recreational competition.

Structured leagues and tournaments are offered in a diverse array of sport activities from flag football and basketball to ultimate frisbee and dodgeball. So satisfy your urge to play!

WHO CAN PLAY?

Currently enrolled WLU students are eligible to enjoy all intramural privileges. Currently employed faculty/staff members are also eligible to participate. Complete eligibility requirements and restrictions are published on the Intramural Sports homepage at westliberty.edu/intramurals

HOW DO I PARTICIPATE IN AN SPORT OR PROGRAM?

To enter an individual sport, stop by the Office of Student Life prior to the registration period to pick up information on the sport you are interested in. The information addresses levels of play, roster requirements, and rules.

WHAT IF I DON'T KNOW ANYONE?

Individuals as well as teams are encouraged to participate in intramurals. Teams are usually formed from residence hall units, student organizations, hometown affiliation, and often simply groups of friends.

However, if you want to play but don't have a double's partner or don't know enough people to form a team, don't worry, we can still get you involved. Please sign up as a "Free Agent." Your name will be available to any other individual as well as team captains looking for players or partners. We will either form a team from other "free agents" or we will try to get you placed on an existing team.

WHEN & WHERE DO GAMES TAKE PLACE?

The Intramural activities at the university are played in and on some of the most outstanding collegiate recreational facilities. Indoor sports take place in Blatnik Gym and the ASRC Basketball takes place in the ASRC. Volleyball, indoor soccer, dodgeball, and floor hockey take place in the Blatnik.

The outdoor intramural facilities are on the same fields our student athletes use. Flag football and soccer teams are also able to compete "under the lights" as their games are scheduled as West Family Stadium.
