Save Time & Money with the 3+2 Bridge Program



WLU's Bridge program allows students to earn their undergraduate degree and graduate degree together. Students can take undergraduate core art therapy classes at graduate level, and it counts for both degrees. Students complete all undergraduate requirements except for the Bridge courses and then switch to graduate studies.

To be a professional in the field of Art Therapy and Counseling, students need a graduate degree. The graduate program provides the education needed to pursue professional certification as an art therapist and licensure as counselor. Postgraduate supervision hours and successfully passing exams are required for professional certification and licensure.
