

### BEST PRACTICES FOR SHOOTING VIDEO - PLANNING

- CREATE A SCRIPT AHEAD OF TIME
- Develop a storyboard or a shot list
- WHAT'S YOUR TARGET LENGTH?
  - LONG VIDEOS LOSE ATTENTION
  - How will you make this interesting and engaging?
- WHAT WILL YOU NEED B-ROLL OF?
- VOICEOVERS VS ON CAMERA

### BEST PRACTICES FOR SHOOTING VIDEO - LIGHTING

• MORE LIGHT = CLEARER IMAGE



### BEST PRACTICES FOR SHOOTING VIDEO - LIGHTING

- MORE LIGHT = CLEARER IMAGE
- Use a soft, omnidirectional light
  - EXAMPLE: RING LIGHT
- WINDOW LIGHT



### BEST PRACTICES FOR SHOOTING VIDEO

#### THINGS TO AVOID:

- HARSH LIGHT
- OVERHEAD FLUORESCENTS
- BACK LIGHTING (WINDOWS OR DARK CORNERS)

# - SOUND

0

- Sound will make or break a video
- INVEST IN A MIC
  - USB MIC (COMPUTER)
  - SHOTGUN MIC OR LAV MIC (CAMERA)
- RECORD IN A QUIET SPACE WITH SOFT EDGES

### BEST PRACTICES FOR SHOOTING VIDEO - ENVIRONMENT

- Avoid cluttered spaces
- Use simple backgrounds
- TURN OFF THE AC
- Consider the sound and lighting constraints
  - CHILDREN
  - Pets
  - TRAFFIC

### BEST PRACTICES FOR SHOOTING VIDEO - ENVIRONMENT



### BEST PRACTICES FOR SHOOTING VIDEO - STAGING AND COMPOSITION

- 2/3 RULE COMPOSITION
- HAVE A BUDDY TO HELP SET UP
- CAMERA PLACEMENT
  - AVOID REALLY LOW ANGLES AND REALLY HIGH ANGLES
- AVOID READING FROM A SCRIPT!

### - PERSONALITY

- BE ENERGETIC!
- Smile and be positive
- EYE CONTACT
- BE YOU
- AVOID THE WEEDS

### CONTENT CREATION LANGUAGE

- SLOW DOWN
- AVOID READING
- ARTICULATE AND ANNUNCIATE
- JUST AS IF YOU WERE TEACHING IN PERSON

### CONTENT CREATION GRAPHICAL ELEMENTS


- Use graphics to help illustrate points
- 6x8 RULE
- VARY YOUR IMAGERY
- BE MINDFUL OF USING CONTENT LEGALLY

# - OTHER CONTENT NEEDS

- ALWAYS CREDIT WHERE CONTENT IS PULLED FROM
- LOOK FOR ROYALTY FREE OR

CREATIVE COMMONS/OPEN SOURCE

- OBS SOFTWARE CAN BE USEFUL FOR SCREEN RECORDING
- SNIPPING TOOL ON WINDOWS MACHINES FOR SCREEN SHOTS



### EDITING PROCESS


- STEP 1 GATHER YOUR ASSETS
  - ON CAMERA NARRATION
  - VOICE OVERS
  - IMAGERY/PHOTOS
  - B-roll
  - AUDIO ELEMENTS (SOUND, MUSIC, ETC)



### EDITING PROCESS


#### • STEP 2 – CREATE

- AND CREATE THOUGHTFULLY
