

PLAN AHEAD

We recommend planning your trip at least one year in advance. This not only helps with academic planning, it also gives you time to save money and to apply for aid and scholarships.

CONSIDER MULTIPLE LOCATIONS

Students are often surprised to discover that some destinations cost about the same as remaining at WLU. Talk to the study abroad coordinator if you want to go abroad and your first priority is keeping costs down.

TALK TO THE FINANCIAL AID OFFICE
