Services are confidential and most are provided <u>free of charge</u> to all students, both resident and commuter, on both an appointment and walk-in basis and include:

-TB Testing (\$10.00)

-Flu Shot (\$20)

-Meningitis vaccine (\$150.00)

- -first aid

Doctors Urgent Care will bill your insurance for X-Rays, labs, and special procedures. All in-office charges not covered by insurance will be written off. If you do not have insurance, all in-office charges will be written off. Certain labs or X-rays sent to an outside facility cannot be written off by Doctors Urgent Care. You and/or your insurance will be billed for services outside of Doctors Urgent Care.
